Tickets: Parents, please note that tickets must be preordered from the FFCC website (www.ffcc.org). **There will be no tickets sales at the show site.** Tickets can only be purchased for portions of the show, these are called 'flights.' We are in **Flight 1** so please make you indicate the correct flight when ordering tickets.

Uniform: Students need to have athletic shorts and a t-shirt under whatever they wear for the trip, so that we can change on the bus. There will NOT be changing rooms at the show site.

What to Bring: 1) Money for dinner. 2) A copy or picture of this itinerary. 3) Black Band shoes! (Everyone's uniform will be at school.) 4) A GREAT attitude and willingness to "go with the flow" when we encounter obstacles or challenges☺

***There will be NO tolerance for misbehavior on the bus. There are cameras on the bus, and any inappropriate behavior will be dealt with swiftly and severely.**

***There is a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for possession of drugs and alcohol. Any student caught in possession of either will be immediately removed from this group and, the harshest punishment possible will be advocated by Dr. Grant.**
